Highlight of the Year: Staff Prayer Summit

A team of ten representatives from **Revive Our Hearts South Africa** (eight team members and two husbands), travelled to Michigan, USA during May 2024 to attend the annual **ROH Staff Prayer Summit**, an event which had left them deeply moved and spiritually refreshed.

The week began with the *ROH Internationals Pre-Summit*, where men and women from around the world gathered to share their personal journeys into ministry with *ROH*. The gathering served as a powerful reminder that God calls ordinary people to do extraordinary work in His Kingdom. At present, *ROH*'s resources are being translated into 22 languages, with nine language representatives present at the event.

Bob Lepine opened the Summit by teaching on the seven churches from Revelation. He highlighted the importance of loving others through acts of service, referencing Revelation 2:19. For the South African team, this message



struck a personal chord, as they had already experienced remarkable hospitality and care from the *ROH* USA staff. "Every need was thoughtfully met, and we could feel God's love through their actions," one team member shared.

An exceptional part of the Summit was a full day set aside for eight hours of uninterrupted prayer. Led by Daniel Henderson, attendees participated in Scripture-based prayer, using a



process of *Read, Reflect, Respond and Receive*. The experience of corporate, Spirit-led prayer left a lasting impression on all involved. "It felt as though every moment of that day was sacred," the team reflected.

As the event drew to a close, the South African delegation returned home with hearts full of gratitude and a renewed vision. The DNA of *ROH*; prayerful leadership, humble service, and Spirit-led ministry, was clearly evident in Michigan and the team is committed to cultivating the same spirit within *ROH* SA.

Retha de Villiers, National Director of *ROH* SA, reflected on the experience: "It is my prayer that the same DNA of prayer and humble service we witnessed in Michigan will continue to grow in South Africa. Is it part of your spiritual DNA too?"

The visit to the *ROH* Summit was a deeply transformative experience for those who attended, shaping their inner spiritual lives and renewing their commitment to humility and holiness. The orderly, Spirit-led leadership moved participants during prayer, worship, and Scripture reading. The unity of the global body of Christ, coming together across nations and languages, sharing community, love, friendship, real testimonies and prayer, was described as breathtaking and deeply encouraging.

Many felt privileged to sit alongside praying and serving women devoted to God's Word, hearing messages that emphasized the diversity and equality of service within the body of Christ.

The gathering was characterized by a profound sense of family among participants, many of whom had never met before but quickly bonded through the evident work of the Holy Spirit. This unity revitalized attendees, inspiring them to return home with renewed energy and vision for leading women in Bible study and

ministry. Encouragement also came from witnessing older women still active and passionate in their calling.

Many reflected on their calling to become more involved and to find new ways to reach more women with the Gospel in a challenging world. Overall, the summit was a profound blessing, renewing spirits, deepening unity, and strengthening a shared global vision. All praise and honour were given to God for the meaningful encounter and the ongoing work He is doing through this ministry.

1.1 Wonder of the Word Project

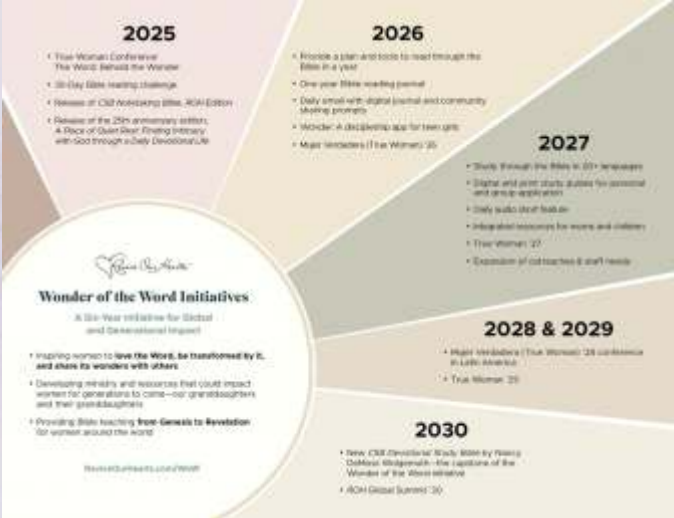
In early 2024 *ROH SA* became part of the **Wonder of the Word** project developed by *ROH Ministries*. This is a six-year project designed to enrich the ministry's teachings and discipleship resources. The focus of the project is:

- to inspire women to love the Word, be transformed by it, and share its wonders with others;
- to developing ministry and resources that could impact women for generations to come, our granddaughters and their granddaughters; and
- to provide Bible teaching to women around the world, from Genesis to Revelation.

With the financial support from *ROHM* we are currently in the process of setting up a recording studio to record the original teachings from Nancy into Afrikaans. Marisa Badenhorst took the responsibility to translate the 260 messages into Afrikaans. Estelle Drysdale was appointed as project manager in February.

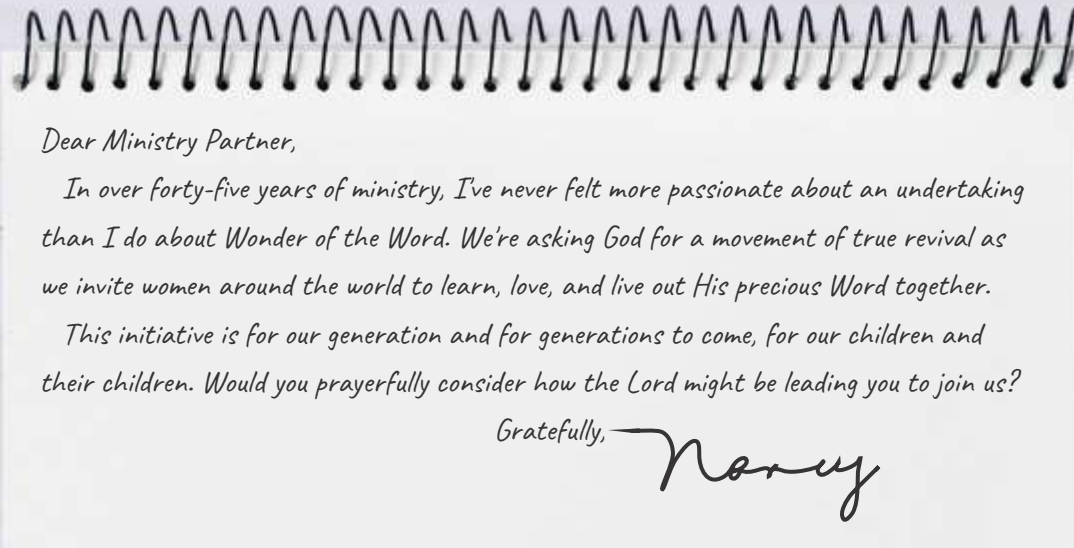

1.2 Seeking Him Podcasts

A strategic focus during this period was the cross-cultural expansion of the ministry through translation initiatives. The ministry actively recruited women from various South African tribes to form dedicated translation teams, making ministry resources, especially the **Seeking Him Podcasts**, available in local languages. This initiative will address the needs of rural communities where oral learning is the predominant mode of instruction. Current translation efforts focus on Afrikaans and Tsonga. New translators are being recruited to expand into additional languages, namely Tswana and Venda.

1.3 ROH SA's Library

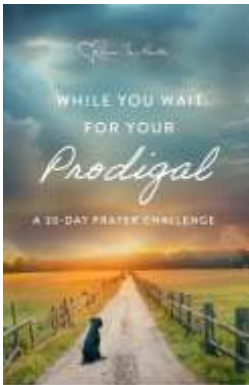
One of the outstanding features of *ROH* is the large number of free resources available to every woman to spiritually grow towards "Freedom, Fullness and Fruitfulness in Christ." Most of these free resources are available on the *ROH* website as podcasts or blogs.

Furthermore, *ROH SA* also has a library in Pretoria where books can be borrowed free of charge. Most of the books in the library have been donated by *ROH* and are primarily books that are not readily available in South Africa.

1.4 Translation and Printing of Resources

1.4.2 Translator team

We want to express our heartfelt thanks to each person who volunteered to assist with the translations. We are in the process of translating *While You Wait for Your Prodigal* into Afrikaans and *Beauty in the Broken* into Tswana.

We find ourselves fortunate to have a group of enthusiastic volunteers. This is a journey that unfolds behind the scenes, yet it requires a significant amount of time and effort. It is also a journey within oneself, for the subject translated speaks deeply to the translator. In the process of refining words and concepts, your own understanding and spiritual growth are sculpted.

Reflecting on the past months, we do so with deep gratitude. The translation work forms a vital and significant part of God's work in and through our ministry here in South Africa.

Translators and prayer teams met in person and online during the *Connect Conference*. We can not translate without prayer covering; thus, we value each prayer for the protection of our translating team.

2. Development and Distribution of New ROH SA Resources

2.1 Bible Reading Plans on YouVersion

Last year, *Revive Our Hearts South Africa* marked a special milestone by publishing its very first Afrikaans *YouVersion* Bible Reading Plan, titled *Innerlike Sterkte* (Inner Strength).

A second reading plan, *Vrug van die Gees* (Fruit of the Spirit), was launched for Christmas 2024. This plan saw remarkable engagement with 1,109 participants and an impressive 83% completion rate.



Both reading plans continue to bless users, with a combined total of 3,706 subscribers and 2,005 completions to date, a 54% overall completion rate.

The ministry is grateful for every reader and encourages more women to join and share these resources as a way to grow spiritually and stay connected in God's Word.

3. Equipping and Supporting Women Leaders

3.1 Team Development and Management

The *ROH SA* team underwent an internal strengthening process during this period. New roles and responsibilities were clarified through individual sessions led by Retha de Villiers, ensuring unity of purpose and operational clarity.

Trello boards were introduced to improve workflow management and project tracking, thereby improving efficiency and collaboration among team members.

3.2 Ambassador Program

Equipping women leaders throughout South Africa remained a priority. *Ambassadors* and *Regional Ministry Partners* actively engaged in training and



support activities. In George, Wilmie van Tonder made significant efforts to introduce *ROH* resources and ministry vision to her local community. She hosted events in Sedgefield and Knysna (Western Cape), connecting with church leaders from various denominations. Year-end gatherings in George brought together 15 women representing eight churches and five nations. In addition to regular coffee meetings, Area Connection meetings were also held biannually, offering ongoing encouragement, training, and spiritual support.

4. Equipping Women of All Generations & Cultures

4.1 Connect Conference (Pretoria)

The **Connect Conference** offered valuable in-person fellowship and teaching opportunities. In October 2024, 120 women gathered in Pretoria for a day of worship, Bible teaching, and panel discussions on topics of faith, marriage, family and cultural engagement.

The opening message, *God wants to connect with you*, was presented by Retha. She taught from the book of Malachi.

- *How to connect with other cultures* - Dudu Masedi, Corné Loots & Pearl Maluleke
- *How to connect with ROH SA* - Wilmie van Tonder
- *How to connect around the table* - A very special session presented by Suria Scoltz



4.1.1 Connect Conference (Mbombela)

In November 2024, Angie Grobler hosted a *Connect Conference* in Mbombela (Nelspruit), welcoming 33 women. Attendees participated in both streamed sessions from the Pretoria Conference and live local panel discussions. These gatherings fostered unity, spiritual renewal, and leadership encouragement.

Streamed sessions led by Retha and Suria were presented to the women, followed by panel discussions led by local women. Topics included:

- *How to stay connected with God* – Diane Illman
- *How to stay connected as a young woman* – Jessica Illman
- *How to connect with other cultures* – Srey, a missionary originally from Cambodia
- *How to connect with ROH* – Angie Grobler

4.2 While You Wait for Your Prodigal Challenge



In response to the increasing number of families burdened by the pain of a loved one who has wandered from the faith, a new resource was successfully developed and launched by ROHM. The project, titled **While You Wait for Your Prodigal: A 30-Day Prayer Challenge**, was

created to offer biblical encouragement, hope, and structured prayer support for those navigating this difficult road.

There were 610 women and a few men in the challenge's *WhatsApp* group. We received very positive feedback and realised how relevant this topic is. After the challenge ended, the team each contacted several people to ask if they had any specific prayer requests. The women who responded to these messages deeply appreciated it.

Testimony: "Going through the *Prodigal Prayer Challenge* has encouraged my heart and allowed me to give this burden to the Lord. Both my kids made a profession of faith as children but have drifted away as adults. I do not have to carry this burden on my own. I can trust Him with my children and will keep praying for them. It has also allowed me to work through my own feelings of guilt, thinking it was because of something I did, or did not do, that they have chosen this path. I can trust Jesus to work it out."

4.3 World Day of Prayer for Women

On 1 March 2024, *Revive Our Hearts South Africa* hosted its first-ever **World Day of Prayer for Women**, a beautiful milestone in the ministry's prayer journey. Led by Retha de Villiers and Suria Scholtz, this online gathering brought 27 women from different regions together in unity and intercession. Amidst the hum of a Friday morning, hearts became silent before the Lord as prayers rose for women across the world.

Participants were reminded of God's constant invitation to draw near, trusting His good purposes in every circumstance. Suria's message offered gentle wisdom on cultivating intimacy with God, encouraging women to quiet their hearts, focus their spirits and intercede with love for one another. It was a precious moment of unity, as women of all ages and walks of life dedicated themselves afresh to Jesus, the one Sovereign over every life and season.

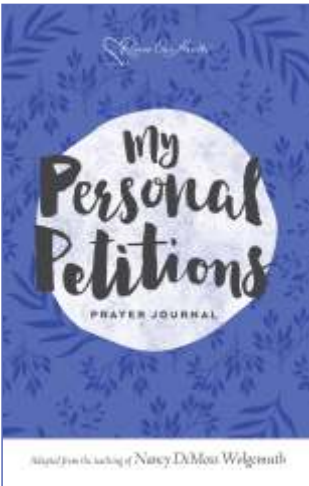
4.4 Bible Study Groups

An online Bible study on the **Song of Solomon** was presented by Retha de Villiers with 52 women participating. The sessions explored the deeper meaning of this often-overlooked book, highlighting how it reflects Jesus' love for His bride, the Church. The study emphasized that while the text speaks about marriage, it ultimately points to the intimate, unwavering love that Christ has for His people.

Testimony: One participant shared how, despite her background in theology, this study profoundly impacted her understanding of God's personal love. She was reminded that she is created by the Creator for His pleasure, cherished above all else, and called into a deep, intimate relationship with Him. Even in moments of neglect, God remains gracious, calling her back into His presence and sending her out to reflect His love in a broken world.

In October and November 2024, Theresa Rabie facilitated the **My Personal Petitions** study online in English.

Carin le Roux, one of the team members, started a Bible study group at her home, beginning with **My Personal Petitions**. Retha de Villiers also led an online group through the book of **Malachi**.



4.5 Book Sales

Book sales have steadily increased over the past 3 financial years and the popularity of different titles varied largely based on the programs focused on, and new translations becoming available.

C. Expansion of Revive Our Hearts South Africa

5.1 Book Tables



- ROH SA had the opportunity to make books available for the book table at three of *Woord en Aksie* (Word and Action) camps: a women's camp, a marriage camp, and a youth camp.
- Marcia Loots also managed a book table at the NG Church Lydenburg South's church bazaar.

5.2 Radio Ministry



On 22 September 2024, the episode of *Vier Die Lewe* (Celebrate Life) on *Radio Pulpit* featured Jackie Arndt, sharing her testimony with a focus on the significance of living a life of prayer. She discussed her involvement with *Mothers*

Who Care and the *Revive Our Hearts Ministry*, emphasizing that prayer is not merely preparation for greater work but is, in itself, the greater work, a sentiment echoed by Oswald Chambers.

Jackie's reflections offered listeners a heartfelt reminder of the transforming power of consistent prayer and its central role in both personal spiritual growth, and community ministry. You can listen to the full episode here: <https://www.iono.fm/e/1486695>.

5.3 Expansion of ROHM in other countries

On 6 July 2024, Theresa Rabie, one of our South African *Ministry Partners*, hosted a *Women's Gathering* in Muscat, in conjunction with her church's leadership. ROHM was introduced to more than 40 expatriate ladies mainly from Southeast Asia, living and working in Oman.



Two ROH books were also donated as thank you gifts to women from Bahrain and India at a *Trauma Healing Workshop* in Muscat, Oman.

6. Operational Areas Supporting Ministry Projects

6.1 Human Resources

Estelle Drysdale is a new member of the *Revive Our Hearts South Africa* team, serving in both operational and project leadership roles. Since February 2024, she has led the new ***Wonder of the Word*** initiative. She also introduced and now oversees data collection and administrative systems using tools like *Google Forms* to support ministry operations and enhance reporting.



6.2 Marketing & Communication

The **digital ministry platforms** of ROH SA experienced encouraging growth over the reporting period. The *Inner Strength YouVersion* reading plan, which launched in December 2023, reached over 900 users within a few months.

By January 2025, the total subscribers across ROH SA's two *YouVersion* plans (*Inner Strength* and *Fruit of the Spirit*) had increased to 3,706 users, with an impressive overall plan completion rate of 54 percent.

6.2.1 ROH SA Website

The **ROH SA website** maintained a stable average of 567 active monthly users. There were notable spikes in activity in October 2024, coinciding with the *Connect Conference* (858 users), and again in January 2025, which reached 1,000 users. The majority of website visitors originated from South Africa (44%) and the United States (24%), with additional international engagement from Mexico, Colombia and China.
